CCO Oregon **welcomes presentation proposals** highlighting innovative payer and provider programs and projects in behavioral and oral health, primary care, pharmacy, and health related social needs from across the coordinated care model. Abstract submissions may be submitted now through Monday, June 12, 2023. Presenters should seek to connect project considerations such as community assessment and health equity goals, data use, measurable outcomes, policy, payment models, and implementation or operations. Featured projects should directly involve at least one of Oregon's CCOs.

Presentation options and parameters

- **Individual presentation:** These will be 10 - 12 minutes in length and should be accompanied by 2 - 4 slides. Three or four presenters with similar themes will be grouped together in a session. There will be time for Q&A at the end of the session.
- **Panel or group presentation:** These sessions will be 50 - 60 minutes in length and should be accompanied by a slide deck. Utilizing no more than 5 speakers, the group will have adequate time to present a coordinated care project or program. The presenters will prepare for 15 minutes of Q&A.
 - *Note: While up to 5 speakers are welcome, complimentary tickets for the conference are only available for 2 speakers per presentation.
- **For all presentations:**
 - All speakers must disclose any conflict of interest relative to the presentation topic and ensure the accuracy and quality of the content delivered.
 - The Salem Convention Center will provide a laptop, projector with remote, projection screen, two microphones, table, and chairs for each presentation.

- June 12—Submit individual and panel presentation titles and abstracts to info@ccooregon.org
- June 28—CCO Oregon responds to proposals with abbreviated abstract drafts
- August 1—Submit presenter full names, 50-word or less bios, professional titles, employers, and individual contact information as well as final abstracts
- August 8—Receive complimentary ticket code to register 2 presenters / panelists
- September 18—Receive final details for the event from CCO Oregon
- September 25—Submit presentation slide deck to info@ccooregon.org
- October 5—Conference day at the Salem Convention Center
- October 12—All presentations and materials posted on www.CCOOregon.org

Proposal submission checklist to be completed by 5pm on Monday, June 12

- Presentation title and abstract (not to exceed 200 words)
 - Slide decks will not be accepted in lieu of an abstract.
 - If your proposal is accepted, CCO Oregon will use your submitted abstract to draft a shorter version (50 words), which you will have an opportunity to edit, for the conference attendee program.
- List the organizations that will be included in the presentation
 - If a proposal is accepted, the final abstract and complete presenter information (full name, title, employer, email, phone number, and bio with less than 50 words) are due to CCO Oregon by August 1.
- Submit proposal pieces to info@ccooregon.org by 5pm on June 12. Only complete submissions will be considered.
